General Visitor Information

The American Solar Energy Society (ASES) has conducted 21 National Solar Tours. The Florida Renewable Energy Association has participated in the ASES Annual National Solar Tour for the past 10 years. FREA is the Florida Chapter of ASES. The event is free to all and no one gets paid during this volunteer event.

Over the years, FREA has used a variety of formats for local events. We have teamed with FLASIEA, UCF, OUC, Ideas, Solar-Users-Group and other organizations. We have had organizations provide sites for the tour from FREA members, the general public and general industry. This 2017, FREA is partnering with FLSUN for an event date of October 21, and will team with FREA members for a tour on October 28.

This year, FREA has scheduled solar tours over two weekends and regionalized to four parts of Florida. We have allocated as many as 12 sites in one day with the attendees deciding which site they wish to attend at their schedule throughout the day, as well as, allocating 6 sites in one day with a set starting site and finish site with a set order. Distance between sites has a lot to do with attendance at each site, as well as, the type of site PV system.

Attendance has varied widely, being as high as 300 in 2013 to as low as 20 in the Spring of 2017. Comparing our attendance with other chapters, we are about average.

- Honor the site date and time of event, do not come at other times
- Look for Street/road signs in front of home or business
- Sign-in or register at site on Sheets for verification of attendance
- Smile, be friendly, learn all you can and experience solar life.

The owner of the system will be at their site during the time of the tour on Saturday. We ask you not to come any other day or time then what is published.

FREA is also concerned about the safety, so follow directions of site owner for your safety. If you need a bathroom, please do so before arriving at the site.
